quotation marks are not added until the speaker changes or the quotation is interrupted. In word processing, use curved or "smart" quotes, rather than straight quotes, which indicate inches. Rule #1: Use double quotation marks to enclose a direct quotation (the exact words spoken by someone).

3. To open a paper with a historical or political quote. Sometimes, quotes by historical or political figures can be useful in setting up the central issue of a paper. This use of quotes is more common in review articles and book chapters than in primary research articles.

6. If the reference to the speaker is in the middle of a quote, the quoted words on both sides of the reference are in quotation marks. (See rule 3). 7. When you change speakers in a paper, you usually begin a new paragraph. 8. Direct quotations are the exact words of the speaker. An indirect quotation tells what the speaker said as told by the writer.

Block Quotation Examples Example 1 . This example demonstrates a block quote. Because some introductory phrases will lead naturally into the block quote, you might choose to begin the block quote with a lowercase letter. In this and the later examples we use "Lorem ipsum" text to ensure that each block quotation contains 40 words or more.

Quotations in a Nutshell Use quotation marks to indicate a person's exact words. Begin every quotation with a capital letter if the quotation marks the beginning of a sentence. Do not use a capital letter for the second part of a quotation that divides a sentence. Do not use quotation marks around indirect quotations.
